

## SCHOOL LEADERSHIP

Cambridge Primary School has an active student leadership team.

As well as eight House Captains, two school captains and two vice captains each of the year 4, 5 and 6 classes nominates two junior school councillors to the student leadership team.

As a team, the students work together and with staff to implement school improvement projects, raise money and awareness of various social justice projects and develop leadership skills and be responsible role models.

## SCHOOL CAPTAINS

Each year two school captains and two vice captains are elected as the school captains. Students in year 5 prepare speeches in term four and are voted in by their peers to represent the school the following year. Outgoing school captains present the new captains with their badges at the last assembly of the year. School captains represent the school and present to the school council each term. They work closely with the school principal ensuring student voice is an integral part of the school's decision making processes, where ever possible.

## HOUSE CAPTAINS

Cambridge Primary School has four Houses – Carruthers (Blue), Westmill (Yellow), Dowling (Red) and Barber (Green). Eight Sport's Captains are selected by their peers each year and they have a leadership role within the school. The sports captains assist the Physical Education teachers in all aspects of the sport, health and physical education program, including setting up for interschool sports, the athletics carnival, the mini Olympics and Footy Day. Each year Cambridge Primary School Sport's Captains attend a "Young Leaders Conference" where they interact with famous or highly successful people who share their personal journeys with the students. This is part of the Leadership Development program at Cambridge Primary School.
